HT2 Topic

This half term our topic is 'Sights and Sounds of Winter'. We will be learning about lots of different celebrations from **Bonfire Night**, Diwali, Halloween, and Christmas. The provision will reflect the teaching so that the children can engage in independent learning which will build on the teaching. We will be focusing on the books 'Room on the Broom' and 'Stick Man' By Julia Donaldson and the children will learn these of by heart using Talk 4 Writing. The children will be taking part in some Science experiments over the weeks and also music sessions and will also be rehearsing songs from our Christmas performance too. We will discuss bonfire and firework safety with our local Police officer, and we will also discuss road safety and how to keep our bodies healthy. In Knowledge and Understanding of the world we will look at the different seasons, Autumn and Winter, and how they compare, and what our outside areas looks like in these seasons.
