What should I already know?

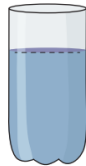
I know there are different seasons.

There are four seasons: autumn, spring, summer, winter.

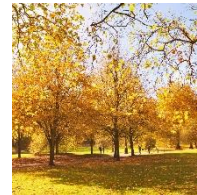
Air temperature changes across the seasons.
