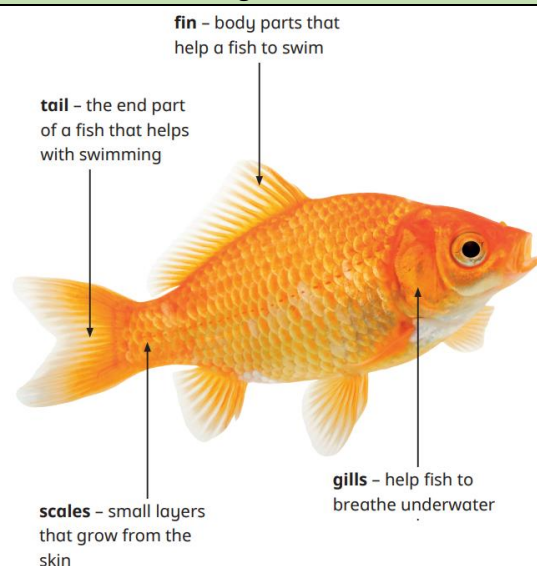

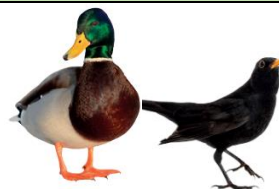
There are five groups of common animals, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals.
