




# Sticky Knowledge

A carnivore is an animal that eats meat.

Herbivores are animals that eat plants and omnivores eat plants and meat.

animal – a living creature



mammal - an animal with fur or hair on its body



**fur** – the fine, soft hair found on different animals



**wild mammal** – a mammal that is not looked after by humans



pet – an animal that is looked after by humans



scales - small, hard layers that grow from the skin
